

- Messaging
  - Even though TCK modernization has delayed release specifications were delivered in the 2 year timeframe.

- What is happening?
  - Reza
    - A lot of failing tests 7k
    - JPA TCK is the big problem at the moment with just 2 people (Scott Stark, Scott Marlow - RH) working part time on them - no ETA from them
    - Current velocity likely months for a Platform release
    - Need to have a sense of urgency
    - MS willing to add some people
