- Milestone 4 is in progress published to Mvn central (updated on June 30). Still need an updated TCK. This release will become 'Release Candidate.' Schemas will also be updated. Still some WIP, but progress is good.
- Platform TCK in two weeks, the TCK team projects they will be able to provide a completion estimate.
 - Platform TCK is now meeting weekly (Wed's at 8AM PDT/11 am EDT)
- The Marketing committee requires a minimum of 6 weeks to be able to prepare properly for the launch of release-related marketing activities.
 - July 2 Update
 - Marketing material is staged as best as possible awaiting final release date. Reminder that the Marketing team needs at least 3 weeks lead time prior to release.
 - Cloud Native survey (technical survey) is in final stages and planned for release July 11. Final discussion will be at the Marketing meeting next week.
 - Discussion about Cloud Native review details. Is it technical enough? Comments about some consistency in the text (e.g. between Jakarta EE and MicroProfile) has filtered into the final survey text.
 - Tanja recommends comments be delivered through the Marketing e-mail list and engage Neil and Shabnam.

 Reza asked what Jakarta EE WG marketing opportunities will be provided/available through the event. Tanja suggests that this discussion be continued with the Marketing team representatives (including Shabnam). Some early-bird material / acceptance notifications should have been made already.

Tanja raised an issue that came up during a private conversation at a technical conference

- There is still confusion about the distinction between Jakarta EE and MicroProfile. A question about how to submit for a new specification and how to decide which working group to work with. Tanja reflected that one potential submitter decided not to submit for a new Specification since they could not determine how best to accomplish their goals.
- Reza noted that, without specific details this might be a difficult issue to troubleshoot.
- Ed Bratt suggested that the working group could be more clear about the specific process / steps to follow to create a proposal for a new specification.
 - To submit a request for a new specification submit a request by creating an issue under the Jakarta EE Specification Issue List. Ultimately these should be submitted as new project requests to the EMO then a creation review In this discussion, we did not conclude a specific sequence of steps. Ed Bratt and Tanja will put together the details for initiating a specification proposal next time
