Jakarta EE 11 Update

- The following reflects the release plan of record
 - o Jakarta EE 11 Release Plan
- Tracking spreadsheet of specifications progressing through the JESP version lifecycle.
 - Almost all ballots complete or in progress two ballots in mentor review no remaining issues. Will be in ballot soon.
 - Hoping Ed/Arjan/Ivar can walk us through this

- The WebSocket, Servlet, Pages spec issues have been "unstuck"
- Mentoring assignments please complete reviews
- Jakarta Data
 - Considering/likely to use Hibernate as a compatible implementation within GlassFish (Hibernate is passing many of the tests)
 - o GlassFish community has raised a concern with the above
 - Open issue to be worked out w/in GlassFish community
- Need to initiate testing of the refactored Platform TCK with GlassFish
- Based on delays of some component spec ballots, and potential continuation of the delay pattern, may need to change the "June/July" target to "July/August" (this is not a statement of delay, just acknowledging the possibility).
- June 4 update
 - Most of the above is resolved
 - GlassFish is passing TCKs that are currently available
 - Work in progress on use of the refactored Platform TCK sizable amount of work
 - Approximately 5 people working on this, do not have a definite ETA for completion at this time.
- The Marketing committee requires a minimum of 6 weeks to be able to prepare properly for the launch of release-related marketing activities.
 - Request: Can we get a confirmation for the release date of 16 July (the current expected release date) by the end of the month?
 - Due to the uncertainties with Platform TCK completion, the Platform team is unable to "confirm" a July 16 GA date.
 - The consensus is that we should complete the technical work as planned and as soon as possible.
 - Based on this, the Marketing Committee should consider what would be an appropriate announcement or marketing launch date, but should not "count on" a July 16 release date.
