November 5 Update

- What is our planned message for the following at JakartaOne Livestream?
 - Core Profile intend to go to ballot next week (possibly by Nov 8) high confidence
 - Web Profile intending to have in ballot by Nov 15 (for JakartaOne Livestream) - less confident than for Core Profile
 - Platform intending to have in ballot by Nov 15 (for JakartaOne Livestream) - less confident than for Core Profile
- Note that a Release plan has been drafted for Jakarta Data (EE 12)
- The intent is to do a press release unless the projected end dates spill into 2025 November 19 Update
 - From Draft Spec Committee Meeting Minutes

- Discussion with respect to EE 11 readiness for Livestream
 - What will the state of the specs be on December 3? Emily provided the following update:
 - Hopefully, the Core Profile ballot will be started this week
 - Significant issues remain for Platform and Web Profile specs. We may not meet the December date. We should assume that Platform and Web Profile specs will not pass in CY2024.
 - What is our collective message regarding EE11 state on Dec 3? The following is a summary of our message on Dec 3. Marketing Committee may adjust but the message will be similar to the following:
 - All component specs are complete
 - Core Profile (we assume) will be in ballot before JakaratOne Liverstream, and we expect it to pass during December.
 - The only remaining issues with Web profile and Platform specs are completion of the TCK tests - we hope for resolution of these issues in early CY2025.
- Neil will discuss with Marketing Committee whether to "announce" Core Profile in December. The general feedback to Neil was to wait until we have better definition of when Web Profile and Platform will be released.
- Members are to provide the list of compatible products that will be available at the time of the release or shortly after (<u>link</u>)
